SJTR CONTRACT REGARDING SALE OR CHANGE OF HANDS OF ADOPTED HORSE

Regardless of circumstances, ADOPTER understands and agrees that _____
adopted on ___/_____/_____,^{NAME OF HORSE} SHALL NEVER be sold by means of equine or livestock auction,
or directly sold for meat/slaughter, and may not be sold, given away, lent, leased or removed
from Adopter's personal supervision except as set forth in the following paragraph regarding
Right of First Refusal.

If at any time, the Adopter wishes to sell, lease, trade, give away or in any way change
control of the above named horse, **South Jersey Thoroughbred Rescue and Adoption**
(SJTR) must be offered right of first refusal and be notified of such by certified mail.

Adopter agrees never to sell horse for slaughter or send through an auction, and understands
that doing so would be in violation of the Right of First Refusal. SJTR has the right to purchase
the horse back by matching a bona fide offer, proof of which will include name, address and
telephone number of intended purchaser.

Should a Right of First Refusal **not** be offered to SJTR, adopter faces possible attorney fees and
costs of rescue and rehabilitation. Failure to notify SJTR of the transfer of said horse is grounds
to void the adoption, transfer and/or sale and the horse may be removed without court order.
